GHOSTS OF THE PAST

It was at Liliesleaf Farm in Rivonia, Johannesburg, that Nelson Mandela posed undercover as the caretaker, alias David Motsamayi, and where 19 senior members of the ANC were arrested, leading to the Rivonia Trial which focused the world's attention on the oppression taking place in South Africa. Liliesleaf was once the secret headquarters of the ANC and birthplace of Umkhonto we Sizwe, and it was where they discussed Struggle strategies. Now reopened as the Liliesleaf Learning Centre, the site comprises a museum, a resource centre with fascinating historical material and records, and a multipurpose Liberation Centre featuring exhibits, an auditorium, curio store and coffee shop. www.liliesleaftrust.co.za
