



LILIESLEAF NOW ACCEPTING ADVANCE BOOKINGS

Liliesleaf Farm, purchased by the South African Communist Party (SACP) in 1961, evolved into the headquarters of Umkhonto we Sizwe (MK), the African National Congress (ANC) military wing, translated as 'the spear of the nation'. The farm, situated just outside Johannesburg was used not only as the High Command of MK, but also as a hideaway and meeting place for the ANC and Congress Alliance senior members.

Liliesleaf will reopen its doors to the public on **09 June 2008** to a very different socio-political landscape and showcase the story of South Africa's transformation to a very diverse audience. **Manor house, thatched cottage** and the **outbuildings** will function as a **walk-through museum**, with **interactive** touch-screen material to lead visitors through the footsteps of the political revolutionaries who showed South Africa the doorway to 'Unity in Diversity'.
